

The following figures are intended as a guide to landholders under the current sharefarming program. Individual entitlements will be determined by the specific soil, hydrological and climatic factors of the particular property.

Landholder entitlements will be standardised for the period of the National Action Plan for Salinity and Water Quality (2006 -2008). If there is an increase in net entitlements it will be passed on retrospectively back to the date of signing.

Payment options (one of the following):

Upfront – an upfront payment payable in 2 instalments of 50% each over the first two years of the contract with an additional cropshare entitlement of either a 15% share in timber harvesting revenue **or** a 10% share in timber harvesting revenue with a 10% share in carbon net revenue.

Annuity - a series of annualised payments over a predetermined term with the additional cropshare entitlement of a 2% share in timber harvesting revenue and a 10% share in carbon net revenue.

Payment entitlements on the following pages are **indicative only.**

MARITIME PINE

Areas within 120 km of Perth, with deep coloured sands, receiving >600mm annual average rainfall. Generally established to *Pinus pinaster*.

Representative centres: Bullsbrook, Gingin, Lancelin

Areas within 120 km of Perth, with deep coloured sands, gravelly sands or deep sandy duplexes, receiving 400-600mm annual average rainfall. Generally established to *Pinus pinaster*.

MARITIME PINE

Areas within 120 – 200 km of Perth with deep coloured sands, receiving 400-600mm annual average rainfall. Generally established to *Pinus pinaster*.

Representative centres: Gillingarra, Moora

The presence of a fresh water table within three metres will generally increase payment entitlements.

Areas within 120 – 200 km of Perth with deep coloured sands, receiving >600mm annual average rainfall. Generally established to *Pinus pinaster*.

WA SANDALWOOD

Heavier loams, gravels and duplex soils receiving >500mm annual average rainfall. Generally established to *Santalum spicatum*.

Representative centres: Dandaragan, Gillingarra, Bindoon, New Norcia, Toodyay, Wandering

Heavier loams, gravels and duplex soils receiving 450-500mm annual average rainfall. Generally established to *Santalum spicatum*.

Representative centres: Moora, Northam, York, Beverley, Brookton

WA SANDALWOOD

Heavier loams, gravels and duplex soils receiving 400-450mm annual average rainfall. Generally established to *Santalum spicatum*.

Representative centres: Yerecoin, Grass Valley, Morbinning

Heavier loams, gravels and duplex soils receiving 350-400mm annual average rainfall. Generally established to *Santalum spicatum*.
