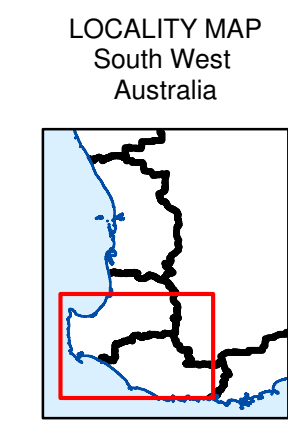


# Indicative 2018 Harvest plan Southern Supply Zone
